At MSC we try to provide a personal touch, one that makes you feel like we are more than a business, but rather an extension to your family.

He started working here in high school and returned to join our management staff upon graduation with a Degree in Business Administration. He is a tumbling coach for 14 years, fitness instructor, and talented athlete. He is 34 years old and is engaged to get married. He loves people and pours himself into trying to give our MSC Family the best experience possible. The kids and families he works with love him!

Karyn Long, Facility Manager has been here at MSC for over 16 years. She is 55, a widow, mother of two children and has one grandson. She is an experienced legal secretary and bookkeeper for 35 years and facilitates the billing/accounting side of camp, as well as other areas at MSC from 7am-3pm daily. Ann Dowdy has been working at MSC for 5 years and is 61 years old. She is now director of Summer Camp, Aftercare Programs, 3 & 4 year old Gymnastics Coach and a fitness instructor and has worked in the fitness/childcare industry for over 20 years. She is mother to two grown sons and is married. She is loved by the children and their families because of her caring and servant demeanor.

Camper to Counselor Ratio: 10:1 with camper to staff ratio. Our staff consists of qualified, responsible and trained adults, college students, and high school students. Once hired, the MSC staff is trained for the first day of camp. All of our employees have been background certified.



CAMP DATES: Our camp will be 10 weeks beginning May 31st -August 6th. Children ages 3-12 years old (must be potty-trained). Our hours will be 9:00am-3:00pm. Car line is from 3:00-3:15pm for campers not staying for after care. Registration Fee: Non-refundable one-time fee of \$50 1st child/ \$35 additional child. Weekly Camp rate is \$155 (includes 2 free snacks a \$15/wk. value & Free Before Care 7-9am). Siblings pay \$140/week (After Care is available from 3-6pm- \$10/day or \$25/week.) **Compare our prices. *Some camps may appear cheaper weekly, but if you look closely, you are paying for snacks and After Care is more expensive.**

*Week 10 will be prorated- \$30/day from 9am-3pm (sibling \$27/day), FREE Before Care from 7-9am and \$5/day After Care from 3-6pm (sibling \$3/day). THIS WEEK IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE SPECIALS OFFERED THROUGH MAY 7TH.

REGISTER NOW/LIMITED ENROLLMENT: At this time, we are planning again for limited capacity due to continual changes in Covid-19 guidelines. Please purchase at least the first 3 weeks of camp that you want your child to attend. We will close weeks once capacity is met. Priority will go to full time campers. Part-time is available if spots are not filled. Only weeks pre-purchased are guaranteed spots. **We will monitor state guidelines and make changes as needed.**

We are encouraging families to purchase the full summer session. The less movement we all have between camp programs, the safer we create our camp environment.

- **EARLY BIRD SPECIAL** will be available February 5th – March 20th (½ off registration fee)
- **REGISTRATION DAY** on March from 1-5pm **FREE** Registration and camp sling bag. **20% OFF DISCOUNT** is available ONLY 21st ON REGISTRATION DAY -if purchase full 9 weeks of camp (must pay at Registration Day (NO EXCEPTIONS), cannot add sibling discount—no refunds) Does not include lunch or after care charges. **Week 10 is NOT included in the specials offered**
- **10% OFF DISCOUNT** is available from February 5th- May 7th. Get 10% off 3+weeks (**must pay in full on the day of signing up, no refunds, no sibling discount and applies to tuition only no after care or lunch charges**). **Week 10 is excluded from this special**).
- **BONUS-** Attend 3 or more weeks of Summer Camp and get swim lessons or gymnastics/tumbling session for special low rate of \$90-SUMMER SESSION Only.

TRANSFER WEEKS: Can only be made towards the payment of another week (not food or aftercare). Email transfer request to info@mandevillesportscomplex.com.

REFUNDS: Credit will be given on pre-paid weeks for extenuating circumstances, **but credit must be used in another program in our facility. All extenuating circumstances must be emailed to info@mandevillesportscomplex.com.** We reserve the right to review and determine whether or not extenuating circumstances presented qualify for a credit.

LUNCH: Campers have the option of bringing or purchasing a lunch each day. Meals catered by: Raising Canes, Nan's Cafe, Subway, Chick Fil A, and Papa John's Pizza. Camp menu will be posted on the website. Snacks are free and are provided twice daily. At second snack time, children can purchase additional items from the Snack Bar. All money for snack bar purchases must be put on a Cafe card and additional funds can be added at any time. Campers will not be allowed to use cash at the snack counter.

JUNIOR COUNSELOR PROGRAM: Our Junior Counselor Program is a wonderful program for your child to participate. They get to have fun and learn the steps to becoming a quality worker for whatever job they choose to work in the future. It is for ages 13-15 year old boys or girls. Spaces are limited this year. We will be handing out applications on our Registration Day, March 21st. If you are unable to attend, you can print an application from our website. There will be sections where the parent and the child sign off on. We will contact you and let you know if you have been accepted into the program. There will be a registration fee to be part of the program. Lunches will be available each day for \$5 or they can bring a lunch from home. We love working with your kids!

COVID 19 CHANGES

- We're excited to announce that we have installed UV lights in all AC units to aid in fight of infections and viruses (including COVID 19).
- Parents will register and/or sign-in at outside tables located at the front desk. After your child's temperature is taken, hands sanitized, and mask in place, a counselor will walk your child inside the building to their designated location. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or greater, loss of smell/taste, stomachache, diarrhea, vomiting or uncontrolled nausea at any time of the day will not be allowed to enter or will be sent home. (Employees will mask, take temperatures, and sanitize hands as well).
- We will be dividing campers into smaller groups as they rotate through various activities throughout the day.
- Masks will be worn ages 8 and up when not playing, eating, swimming, or working out. Children of all ages are welcome to wear a mask. Masks will be labelled and stored in a plastic bag when not in use for any of above reasons. Counselors will hold these and redistribute to campers.
- Handwashing will be required to enter the building, before/after eating, restroom and transition times as well as encouraged throughout the day. Surface areas will be sanitized throughout the day at one of our sanitation stations.
- Lost & found is located outside in a container by the café pick up window.

BULLYING 2021

We would like to address the topic of bullying. We have no desire to see any of our campers bullied. However, we feel the term is at times misused, too broad, overgeneralized, and misunderstood. Part of the learning curve is learning how to deal with a variety of emotions and behaviors. I want kids to be able to recognize when they are pushing kids' buttons or having their buttons pushed. Want them to learn to recognize when they need to walk away.... We are not all created equal, and do not all respond the same way in given situations. Additionally, home environment, amount of community exposure, and personality style greatly affects how a child responds. Life is a journey of learning for us all.

Our MSC staff desires to listen to children express their concerns related to the behavior of other children around them, as well as when they are struggling with how they are responding to the children around them. We think that learning conflict resolution is a vital skill; one that we hope to help them develop. That is why our staff takes time to talk with all the children involved in situations where we are told a child is saying hurtful, mean, or putdown comments, as well as those about kids playing too rough or leaving them out. When we deem necessary children are removed from activities, put in time out, write lines, and/or parent called. If no improvement, a camper can be asked to leave camp for the day or indefinitely. We want kids to enjoy their time at MSC. Sometimes what goes home is only part of what happened. Kids can have amnesia when it comes to their part in "why" the conflict occurred.

LIST OF REMINDERS AND THINGS THAT SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO CAMP EVERY DAY:
You are required to check in at the front desk and sign out every day by side café entrance.
MSC staff will mark time in and time out and lunch orders.

EMERGENCY CARD must be completed. On the first day your child attends camp, you will receive your CODE NUMBER. Your child will only be released to people who know your child's CODE NUMBER. If you do not know your code, you will be asked to present a photo id, and your child will be released only if your name is on your Emergency Card.

- Children in grades PK-1st must bring a change of clothes every day.
- Please wear camp shirt every day. Write your child's name on shirts and bag. No one will be allowed on field trips without a camp shirt on. T-shirts will be distributed on your child's first day of camp. If you forget your camp shirt, your child will be given a t-shirt and you will be billed \$12 for a new one.
- All medication must be checked in at the front desk and form completed.
- Kids swim every day unless it is a rainout. They should wear their swimsuits under their clothes each day. This limits the dressing time to 1X/day. Outdoor play block is offered during this time, but swimsuits should still be worn so that the option to swim/cool off in pool is available. Sunscreen should be applied to camper before he/she comes to camp. If your child burns easily, they may bring sunscreen, stick, or spray only. Please label all belongings.
- Please bring a clean dry towel each day and a **waterproof bag** for wet swimsuit and wet towel.
- Campers should wear tennis shoes every day for outdoor play AND bring a pair of swim shoes or sandals for swim time.
- Lunch is catered each day. The kids will be allowed to bring lunches from home. No sharing of food will be allowed. We are asking that kids not bring any peanut products. Please make sure your child knows if he/she needs a lunch. If your child eats a lunch, you will be charged.
- Campers can bring money if they want to purchase extra snacks from the snack bar (we provide 2 snacks daily). Money is collected at the front desk and funds are put on a Snack Card. Funds can be added at any time. Campers will not be allowed to use cash at the snack counter.
- **Carline & After Care Pickup** – Kids cannot be checked out at the front desk after 2:15pm. Car line and After Care pick up is on the side of the building by the café entrance. Car line will begin at 3:00 pm and ends at 3:15pm. Counselor will walk kids to parent's vehicle. If your child is not picked up by 3:15pm they will join our after care. Parent will sign out after care kids at the side café window.
- Please advise your camper that all counselors and/or chaperones MUST be respected and obeyed. **Bad behavior, bullying, cursing and/or fighting will not be tolerated at any level.** *See attached Bully Protocol.
- **We DO NOT ALLOW ANY electronic phones, games, or toys at camp.** Gym telephones are available for use with permission at any time.
- **All extenuating circumstances must be in writing and emailed to Info@MandevilleSportsComplex.com for consideration.** Please address any concerns (including billing) timely so that they can be handled in the time frame they occur.

I hereby voluntarily waive any and all claims resulting from ordinary negligence, both present and future, that may be made by me, my family, estate, heirs, or assigns.

Further, I am aware that gymnastics and cheerleading are vigorous sporting activities involving height and rotation in a unique environment and as such they pose a risk of injury. I understand that gymnastics, cheerleading, and related activities always involve certain risks, including but not limited to, death, serious neck and spinal injuries resulting in complete or partial paralysis, brain damage, and serious injury to virtually all bones, joints, muscles, and internal organs, and that the mats, pits, and other safety equipment and apparatus provided for my protection, including the active participation of a coach or teacher who will spot or assist in the performance of certain skills, may be inadequate to prevent serious injury. The risk of harm may be limited by all the safety equipment and trained coaches, but never eliminated. I understand that participation in gymnastics and related activities involves activities incidental to active participation in gymnastics, including moving from event to event, conditioning, stretching and other activities which may leave me vulnerable to the reckless actions of other participants who may not have complete control over their actions or who may not see other students in the gym. I am voluntarily participating in this activity with knowledge of the risks involved and hereby agree to accept any and all inherent risks of property damage, personal injury, or death.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless MANDEVILLE SPORTS COMPLEX, INC. and all others listed for any and all claims arising as a result of my engaging in or receiving instruction in activities incidental thereto, whenever, wherever, or however the same may occur. If an injury occurs, the party hereby contracts and agrees that their individual medical coverage is deemed primary in any and all situations.

I give permission to MANDEVILLE SPORTS COMPLEX, their officers, and staff, to provide medical treatment in case of an emergency or injury.
