CAMP DATES: Our camp will be 10 weeks beginning May 25th-July 31st. ***We will offer Holiday Camp August 3rd-7th) but these days are not considered for ANY special promotions.*** Children ages 4*-12; Kindergarten* (4 year old must turn 5 before 2026 School Year) through 6th grade (*must be potty-trained and entering Kindergarten in Fall, 2026 and cannot be in 7th grade or above). Our hours will be 9:00am-3:00pm. Car line is from 3:00-3:30pm for campers not staying for after care.

Registration Fee: Non-refundable one-time fee of \$75 for 1st child and \$50 each additional child. Weekly Camp rate is \$180.00 (includes 2 free snacks a \$15/wk. value & Free Before Care 7-9am). Siblings pay \$165.00/week. We offer After Care from 3-6pm- \$15/day or \$50/week and Siblings are \$10/day or \$35/week. **Compare our prices. *Some camps may appear cheaper weekly, but if you look closely, you are paying for snacks and After Care is more expensive.**

REGISTER NOW/LIMITED ENROLLMENT: Our weeks fill up quickly. Waiting lists will be available.

A \$25.00 administrative fee will be added to all transfer requests that can be accommodated. Submission of request must be made prior to the week you are trying to transfer from.

LUNCH: Campers have the option of bringing or purchasing a lunch each day. Lunch cost is \$8.00 per day. Meals catered by: Nan's Cafe, Papa John's Pizza and Raising Canes. Camp menu will be posted on the website. Snacks are free and are provided twice daily. At second snack time, children can purchase additional items from the Snack Bar. All money for snack bar purchases must be put on a Cafe card and additional funds can be added at any time. Campers will not be allowed to use cash at the snack counter.



MSC Conflict Resolution Policy

MSC believes in a team approach to Conflict Resolution: Staff, Parent and Camper. We believe conflict resolution is a vital life skill, one that we hope to help your child with this summer.

MSC Staff will:

- Allow campers to express their concerns related to interaction with the campers around them.
- Help campers with any struggles they may have with how they respond/interact with other campers.
- Listen and talk with all involved.
- Communicate with parent via phone call, text and/or email.

(Please email any concern timely so that it can be resolved. A meeting can be scheduled if deemed necessary)

- I consider it a privilege to attend MSC Summer Camp and understand that I will be expected to treat all staff and campers with kindness and respect.
- I agree to follow all of the rules as listed and as directed by staff.
- I understand that if I choose to not follow the rules I may be removed from an activity, put in time out , write lines and/or a parent may be called. Discipline may include suspension or dismissal. If no improvement the camper will be asked to leave for the day or indefinitely.

LIST OF REMINDERS AND THINGS THAT SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO CAMP EVERY DAY:

You are required to check in at the front desk and sign out every day by side café entrance.

MSC staff will mark time in and time out and lunch orders.

EMERGENCY CARD must be completed. On the first day your child attends camp, you will receive your CODE NUMBER. Your child will only be released to people who know your child's CODE NUMBER. If you do not know your code, you will be asked to present a photo id, and your child will be released only if your name is on your Emergency Card.

- Children in grades K-1st must bring a change of clothes every day.
- Please wear camp shirt every day. WRITE YOUR NAME ON EVERYTHING INCLUDING SHIRTS, SHOES, TOWELS, BATHING SUITS AND BAG. No one will be allowed on field trips without a camp shirt on. T-shirts will be distributed on your child's first day of camp. If you forget your camp shirt, your child will be given a t-shirt and you will be billed \$15 for a new one.
- All medication must be checked in at the front desk and form completed.
- Kids swim every day unless it is a rainout. They should wear their swimsuits under their clothes each day. This limits the dressing time to 1X/day. Outdoor play block is offered during this time, but swimsuits should still be worn so that the option to swim/cool off in pool is available. Sunscreen should be applied to camper before he/she comes to camp. If your child burns easily, they may bring sunscreen, stick or spray only. Please label belongings.
- Puddle jumpers are required for non-swimmers. We determine this weekly with a swim test. If your child does not have a puddle jumper, we will supply one and bill your account \$30.00. They are sold at Walmart and other locations
- Please bring a clean dry towel each day (no beach towels) and a waterproof bag for wet swimsuit and wet towel.
- Campers should have one pair of shoes.
- Lunch is catered each day. The kids will be allowed to bring lunches from home. No sharing of food will be allowed. We are asking that kids not bring any peanut products. Please make sure your child knows if he/she needs a lunch. If your child eats a lunch, you will be charged. DISPOSABLE WATER BOTTLES ONLY.
- Campers can bring money if they want to purchase extra snacks from the snack bar (we provide 2 snacks daily). Money is collected at the front desk and funds are put on a Snack Card. Funds can be added at any time. Campers will not be allowed to use cash at the snack counter.
- **Carline & After Care Pickup** – Kids cannot be checked out at the front desk after 2:15pm. Car line and After Care pick up is on the side of the building by the café entrance. Car line will begin at 3:00 pm and ends at 3:30pm. Counselor will walk kids to parent's vehicle. If you need to fasten your child into car seat, you will need to pull into a parking spot. If your child is not picked up by 3:30pm they will join our after care. Parent will sign out after care kids at the side café window.
- Please advise your camper that all counselors and/or chaperones MUST be respected and obeyed. Bad behavior, bullying, cursing and/or fighting will not be tolerated at any level.
- Lost & found is located outside in a container by the café pick up window. Items will be removed every Friday night. Only items with names on them will remain.
- **We DO NOT ALLOW ANY electronics, phones, smart watches, games, stuffed animals or toys at camp.** Gym telephones are available for use with permission at any time.

Credit will be given on pre-paid weeks for extenuating circumstances, **but credit must be used in another program in our facility. Refunds will not be available.** Extenuating circumstances and illnesses are not automatically excused. All extenuating circumstances must be emailed prior to absence or if child is sick, by 8am that morning or it will not be excused. We reserve the right to review and determine whether or not extenuating circumstances presented qualify for a credit. All billing inquiries should also be made immediately.

Further, I am aware that gymnastics and cheerleading are vigorous sporting activities involving height and rotation in a unique environment and as such they pose a risk of injury. I understand that gymnastics, cheerleading, and related activities always involve certain risks, including but not limited to, death, serious neck and spinal injuries resulting in complete or partial paralysis, brain damage, and serious injury to virtually all bones, joints, muscles, and internal organs, and that the mats, pits, and other safety equipment and apparatus provided for my protection, including the active participation of a coach or teacher who will spot or assist in the performance of certain skills, may be inadequate to prevent serious injury. The risk of harm may be limited by all the safety equipment and trained coaches, but never eliminated. I understand that participation in gymnastics and related activities involves activities incidental to active participation in gymnastics, including moving from event to event, conditioning, stretching and other activities which may leave me vulnerable to the reckless actions of other participants who may not have complete control over their actions or who may not see other students in the gym. I am voluntarily participating in this activity with knowledge of the risks involved and hereby agree to accept any and all inherent risks of property damage, personal injury, or death.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless MANDEVILLE SPORTS COMPLEX, INC. and all others listed for any and all claims arising as a result of my engaging in or receiving instruction in activities incidental thereto, whenever, wherever, or however the same may occur.
